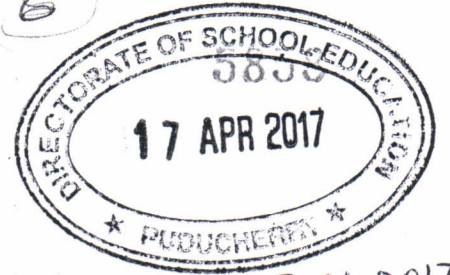

Sub: Mandatory wearing of helmet – Reg.

It is notable that out of total sale of vehicles in Puducherry 85% are two wheelers. In the year 2016-17 out of the total road accidents of 1755, the number fatalities were 219. Out of these accidents, 831 accidents are related to two wheelers and the number of fatalities from two wheelers are 79. A quality ISI certified helmet reduces the chances of severe head injury by over 70%.

In order to control the increasing accident rate, in the State Road Safety Council in its second meeting held under the chairmanship of Hon'ble Chief Minister, Puducherry on 25.01.2017 decided to strictly enforce compulsory wearing of helmet for both Two wheeler drivers and riders from 01-05-2017 onwards. Those who do not follow the regulation are liable to be penalized with a penalty of Rs.100/- at the first instance and Rs.300/- for the subsequent offences. The Transport Department in its circular cited above has requested all the Heads of Department/Officers with request that the officials / Staffs adhere to the above provisions.

As educating student community with basic rules of Road Regulation will ensure their safety, the Head of the Educational Institutions may be directed to arrange to educate the need of wearing helmet and ensure that the staff and student wear helmet while driving two wheeler or riding the same.

In this regard an informative press release had been issued by the Transport Department the content of the same is enclosed. It is requested that the content of the press release may be circulated to all the schools and colleges in the Union Territory of Puducherry for information and strict adherence.
