CIRCULAR

Sub: RMSA - Readiness Programme for Students entering Secondary Education
– 9th Standard for the academic year 2017-18 - Reg.

Since RTE Act 2009, mandates 'No Detention Policy' upto 8th standard, it has become the responsibility of the schools to bridge the gaps in the scholastic abilities during the transition of students from 8th to 9th Standard.

The students with 14 years of age or more and have completed 8 years of study under Elementary Education under 'No Detention Policy', are at a greater risk in coping up with the curriculum of 9th standard. The transition from 8th to 9th Standard becomes a challenge for many students and hard to adjust.

To overcome this situation, a **Readiness Programme for Students entering Secondary Education i.e. 9th Standard**, may be organised in the schools for the students to fit themselves with the new curriculum. The programme shall include the following Modules:


- I. Sensitising the parents of their Role and Responsibilities
- II. Motivating students by renowned and successful persons in the society
- III. Creating awareness among the students about the curricula and syllabi of the subjects and evaluation pattern of 9th Standard
- IV. Sensitising the Promotion criteria from 9th to 10th standard
- V. Building Rapport between Students and Teachers
- VI. Guidance and Counseling for students
- VII. Scenario of Quality Education in UT of Puducherry.

The Head of institutions are requested to arrange for the "**Readiness Programme for Students entering Secondary Education i.e. 9th Standard**" for 2 days duration inclusive of a session for Parent-Teacher's meeting on Sensitising the Role and Responsibilities of Parents.

An amount of Rs. 2,000 may be utilized from School Grant under RMSA for the conduct of this programme.
