NOTIFICATION

In exercise of the powers conferred by the proviso to article 309 of the Constitution of India, read with the Notification No. F. 5/4/65-GP, dated the 11th January, 1965 of the Government of India, Ministry of Home Affairs, New Delhi, the Lieutenant-Governor, Pondicherry, hereby makes the following rules, regulating the method of recruitment to the Group 'B' post of Vice-Principal of Higher Secondary School, in the Education Department, Pondicherry, namely:—

1. *Short title and commencement.*— (1) These rules may be called the Government of Pondicherry, Education Department, Group 'B' Post of Vice-Principal of Higher Secondary School Recruitment Rules, 1989.

(2) They shall come into force on and from the date of their publication in the official gazette.

2. *Number of posts, their classification and scale of pay.*— The number of the said posts, their classification and the scale of pay attached thereto shall be as specified in columns 2 to 4 of the Schedule annexed hereto.

3. *Method of recruitment, age limit and other qualifications.*— The method of recruitment to the said posts, age limit, qualifications and other matters relating thereto shall be as specified in columns 5 to 14 of the said Schedule.

4. *Disqualifications.*— No person,—

(a) who has entered into or contracted a marriage with a person having a spouse living; or

(b) who, having a spouse living, has entered into or contracted a marriage with any person,

shall be eligible for appointment to the said posts :

Provided that the Lieutenant-Governor, may, if satisfied that such marriage is permissible under the personal law applicable to such person and the other party to the marriage and there are other grounds for so doing, exempt any person from the operation of this rule.

5. *Power to relax.*— Where the Lieutenant-Governor, is of the opinion that it is necessary or expedient so to do, he may, by order, for reasons to be recorded in writing and in consultation with the Union Public Service Commission, relax any of the provisions of these rules with respect to any class or category of persons.

6. *Saving.*— Nothing in these rules shall affect the reservations and other concessions required to be provided for the scheduled castes, the scheduled tribes and other special categories of persons in accordance with the orders issued by the Government from time to time in this regard.

Note: The proceedings of the Departmental Promotion Committee relating to confirmation shall be sent to the Commission for approval. If, however, these are not approved by the Commission a fresh meeting of the Departmental Promotion Committee to be presided over by the Chairman or a member of the Union Public Service Commission shall be held.

14. Circumstances in which Union Public Service Commission is to be consulted in making recruitment. Consultation with Union Public Service Commission is not necessary.
