All the Heads of Institutions are instructed to download the respective District Report Cards and State Report Card and disseminate the same to the teachers, SMC members and parents for their perusal and information so that they can contribute accordingly.

All Inspecting Officers, Officials from Samagra Shiksha, faculties from DIET & STC and eminent teachers attended the State Level and District Level Consultative meetings to identify the activities to attain the Learning Outcomes through Immediate, Short and Long Term interventions.

To attain the Learning Outcomes and to improve the quality of education, all the Heads of Institutions and teachers are instructed to follow the following necessary instructions.

1. A Hand Book for Learning Outcomes has been issued to all the teachers handling class I to VIII. The teachers should teach the subjects based on the Learning Outcomes. Posters have been displayed in the class rooms and Leaflets have been issued to the parents in the vernacular language also.
2. Learning Objectives have been listed before each chapter for newly introduced Text Books for class I, VI and IX. Teachers should teach each chapter based on the Learning Objectives. The new Text Books contain the QR Codes for downloading the books, video contents and other related e-contents. Teachers can utilize the web links in ICT lab or use Smart phones or tabs with Apps for downloading and showcasing the video contents available in the new Text Books.
3. Weekly test for each subject must be conducted based on the Learning Outcomes and Slow Learners shall be identified for each subject and special coaching/teaching shall be given to the students for attaining the Learning Outcomes. A separate register has to be maintained by subject teachers and monitored by Head of Institutions and Inspecting Officers.
