
@ Rs.25,000/- per school for students enrolment up to 100 (including at-least Rs 2,500 for Swachhta Action Plan)

@ Rs.50,000/- per school for students enrolment from 101 to 250 (including at-least Rs 5,000 for Swachhta Action Plan)

@ Rs.75,000/- per school for students enrolment from 251 to 1000 (including at-least Rs 7,500 for Swachhta action Plan)

@ Rs.1,00,000/- per school for students enrolment above 1000 (including at-least Rs 10,000 for Swachhta action Plan)

The guidelines for utilization of Composite School Grant are given overleaf. The Head of Institutions are instructed to get entries made in the pass book, to confirm the ECS payment to their bank accounts and utilize the funds for the purpose for which it is granted. Further it is requested to ensure that the funds are spent through the respective School Management Committee.



5. Must involve elements of community contribution.
6. There must be transparency in utilization and provision of funds for social Audit.
7. To be spent only by VEC/SMC/SMDC
